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At a glance

Indition Content Management (the **Cms** module) is the back-office workspace for building and running a site's public website — pages, layouts, navigation, media and the publishing rules that decide when each version goes live. Content is authored with no-code **widgets**, framed by reusable **templates**, and published safely through **workflows** (a private draft channel and a public live channel) with full revision history.

Core capabilities

Area	What it gives you
Sites	Run one or many brands from a single platform, each with its own domains, content database and theme.
Workflows & publishing	Separate draft from live: a page version is only public once you assign its revision to the live workflow — now or on a schedule.
Pages	A drag-orderable page tree (parents/children), with CMS, Standard (module), Group, System and Email-Template page types.
Templates & Template Builder	Reusable layouts with named containers, parent/child inheritance, wrapper templates, per-revision CSS/JS, live draft validation and preview.
Content Editor & widgets	Place, arrange and configure content blocks in template containers; 40+ widget types; full widget edit history.
Revisions & A/B testing	Every save is a revision; different revisions can be live in different workflows at once; run two revisions side by side as an A/B test.
SEO & discoverability	Sitemap generation, dynamic <code>robots.txt</code> , per-page metadata / structured data, full-text on-site search.
Scheduling	Publish and un-publish pages automatically at a chosen date/time, with advance email notifications (with file attachments).
Import / Export	Move pages (with assets and revisions) between environments as a ZIP.
Supporting tools	Contact-form submissions, search-query log, HTTP error log, user-agent rules, themes and the File Manager.

Publishing model

- A **Site** contains one or more **Workflows**; each workflow answers on its own domain(s).
- Workflow **types**: *Initial* (development — new pages appear here automatically), *Final* (the public live site), and *Normal* (extra staging/test channels).

- A **Page** is built on a **Template** and filled with **Widgets**; each saved state is a **Revision** made visible by assigning it to a workflow.
- **Compare pages** and **Compare settings** show exactly what differs between two workflows before you publish.

Widget catalog

Widgets are the no-code building blocks placed on pages. The catalog includes:

Text & media

Rich Text, Pure HTML, Image, Rotating Images (slideshow), Video, YouTube, Vimeo, Button, Icon Box, Spacer.

Navigation & search

Navigation Menu, Search, Sitemap, Popular Search Terms, Site Links Search Box.

Social & embeds

Facebook Embed, Instagram Embed, X (Twitter) Embed, TikTok Embed, Social Share, Google Reviews.

Forms & accounts

Contact Us, Email Subscription, Sign Up, Login, User Info.

Interactive & layout

Countdown Timer, Map, Accordion, Tabs, Announcement Bar, Cookie Consent, Pass Code, Current Geo Location, Recently Viewed Pages, Recommended Pages.

Code, analytics & SEO

Markup Code, HTML Embed, CSS Code, JavaScript Code, Google Analytics 4, Google Tag Manager, Google Tracking (Events & Conversions), Google Tracking (legacy GA), Facebook Tag (Pixel), Metadata, AMP Discoverable.

Some widgets — analytics tags, custom code and SEO metadata — work behind the scenes and render nothing visible on the page.

Performance & security

- **Caching** — per-page HTML and per-widget caching toggles, plus compiled-template caching, for fast delivery.
- **Token-based templates** — templates render from safe placeholders (`#__CONTENT__#` , `#__TITLE__#`) rather than inline PHP.
- **Signed widget settings** — front-end widget settings are signed so they can't be tampered with in the browser.
- **SSRF guard** — server-side URL fetches (e.g. importing an external image) are validated against private/loopback addresses.
- **Role-based access** — admin screens require CMS-admin rights; pages and whole workflows can be restricted to chosen roles, with login enforcement.

Admin entry points	Content Management menu → Pages, Templates, Workflows, Sites, Scheduling, URLs, robots.txt, Contact Us, HTTP Errors, Search Query Log
Scheduled jobs	Page Scheduler (scheduled publish/unpublish); Google Reviews sync
Migrations	Applied via <code>/admin/Admin/patches</code> or a clean install

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
